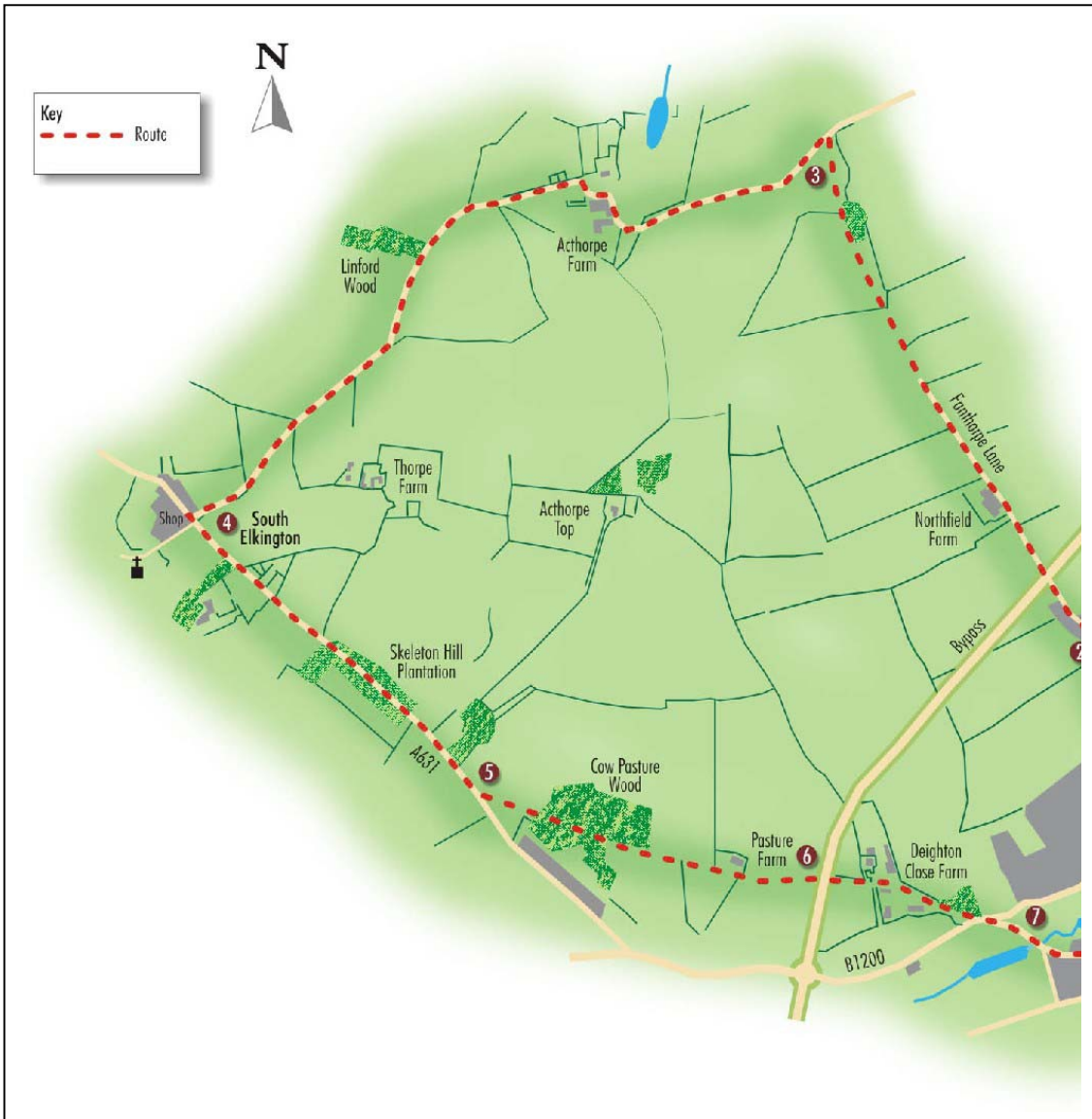


## On Top of the Wolds

A circular walk of 5 ½ miles from the historic town of Louth, through South Elkington and surrounding countryside.

- 1 From St James' Church, walk along Bridge Street.
- 2 Continue up the hill, Grimsby Road, until you reach Fanthorpe Lane, just before a petrol station. Turn left into Fanthorpe Lane. When you reach the bypass, cross with extreme care. Continue on the metalled track, then grass track and across fields until you reach a road.
- 3 At the road turn left. As you go past Linford Wood, you are at the highest point on the walk at 340 feet. Follow the road until you reach South Elkington village.
- 4 Turn left at the road and follow the tarmac footpath towards Louth.
- 5 Turn left at the public footpath and follow it uphill across a field into Cow Pasture Wood.  
  
Once through the woodland, follow the path over the grassland, keeping the trees and hedge on your left, passing Pasture Farm to the bypass.
- 6 Carefully cross the bypass, and go over the stile into the field. Cross the field with the hedge on your left. At the stony track, turn right. Follow the track past the buildings and turn left at the road.
- 7 Ignoring a road on the left, follow Westgate back to St James' Church.
