**Details** : Practical conservation day in Thorganby, Lincolnshire. Our aim is to carefully remove unwanted scrub along the banks of the chalk stream that can quickly over-shade the stream if left. The purpose is to improve the habitat for water loving creatures such as water vole and brown trout.

If safe to do so, there may also be time to do a stream dip where we may conduct a basic survey for stream invertebrates, vital to the chalk streams ecosystem.

Please wear suitable clothing i.e. long trousers and long sleeved top, and bring waterproofs just in case! Suitable footwear is essential - wellies or a sturdy pair of walking boots. If you've got waders please bring them along! Please bring a pack lunch and a drink.

No previous knowledge or experience needed, just your enthusiasm!
